URUGUAY ROUND ISSUES

This bibliography covers secondary legal sources on issues currently under discussion in the Uruguay Round of negotiation on the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (GATT). The sources included directly treat issues discussed at the Uruguay Round or reflect legal aspects of the GATT in light of the talks. The bibliography is divided into sections based upon the most commonly discussed aspects of the GATT and current negotiations. Articles and books are grouped separately within each section and listed alphabetically. Other than select United States government publications, primary sources by the GATT Secretariat or various national governments have been omitted.
